

REQUIRED CYBERSECURITY TRAINING

In alignment with the University System of Georgia cybersecurity training requirements, all Kennesaw State University employees must complete mandatory cybersecurity training twice a year. You will receive a system-generated email on September 30 titled "You've been enrolled in the Fall 2022 Mandatory Cybersecurity Awareness Training," with a link to the training.

Reminder emails will also include a link to the required training, which will be available until October 31. This training is delivered via the USG-provided cybersecurity training platform "KnowBe4" and takes about 15 minutes to complete.

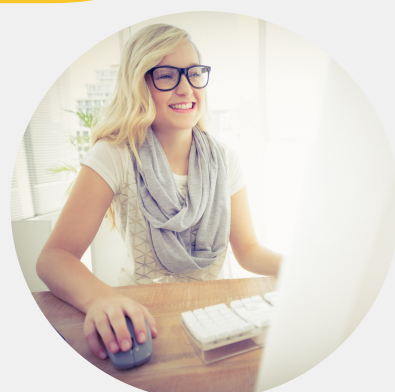
